\$25,000 INSURANCE CERTIFICATE

APPLIANCE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT AND CONNECTED ELECTRONIC AND/OR ELECTRO-MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT POLICY UP TO \$25,000.00 OF COVERAGE

Subject to the limitations set out herein, including the damage limits. Eastern Eco Power LLC. Shall at its sole option either pay the present fair market value or pay the cost of the repair, up to the maximum amount set forth below, for any standard residential electronic and/or electro-mechanical equipment and appliance(s) (as outlined below), which has sustained damage from transient surges while the PCU is connected to the electrical system and is properly functioning/used for the purposes that it was intended. Damages from direct catastrophic lightening hits and surges or spikes originating from cable, phone or DSL lines are not covered under this policy. The connected equipment policy applies to standard residential electronic and/or electro-mechanical equipment and appliances. Electronics installed into the appliances, by the manufacturer, during the original manufacturing process are covered by this policy. Any claim for damages under this repair or replacement policy shall be limited to Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) per item up to but not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) per occurrence. Eastern Eco Power LLC. shall not and will not be liable for any incidental, consequential, or special damages or any economic loss.

The following policy terms apply:

1. **MEDICAL, LIFE SUPPORT, AND SECURITY EQUIPMENT IS EXPRESSLY EXCLUDED. DO NOT USE PCU SYSTEMS FOR SECURITY, MEDICAL OR LIFE SUPPORT EQUIPMENT OR OTHER HIGH RISK ACTIVITIES.**
2. The PCU system must be deemed to have failed due to the surge based on Eastern Eco Power LLC.'s factory testing procedures.
3. Well pumps will only be covered if mounted more than ten (10) feet from the appliance or the thermostat is not connected to the electrical system that is being protected by the PCU system.
4. A certified electrician must have properly installed the PCU system according: to the PCU installation instructions and in compliance with all electrical and safety codes of the most current National Electrical Code ANSI/NFPA 70 and Underwrites Laboratory certification specifications.
5. Where the damaged residential electrical equipment, as outlined above, is covered under a manufacturer's warranty, any applicable extended warranties or insurance policies the PCU policy subrogates to all other warranties, insurance and any other coverage's of the claimant.
6. Standard residential electronic and/or electro-mechanical equipment and appliances shall be limited to: refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, freezers, furnaces, home computers, televisions, home entertainment systems, alarm systems, air conditioning equipment and well pumps.
7. Service charges, installation fees and diagnostic fees are not covered under this policy.
8. A damage claim must be made within ten (10) days of the occurrence and the PCU system must be returned to Eastern Eco Power LLC. for testing within fifteen (15) days of occurrence.
9. Thermostats are not covered if mounted more than ten (10) feet from the appliance or the thermostat is not connected to the electrical system that is being protected by the PCU system.
10. The claimant must complete a PCU **Insurance Claim Form** describing the circumstances of the PCU failure.
11. All returned products must have a return authorization number assigned by Eastern Eco Power LLC.
